



Residential Energy Efficiency Guide

Tips to reduce energy consumption



Turn off the lights

Only turn on the lights that you're using and use natural light when possible!



Lightbulbs

Make sure all your lightbulbs are efficient LEDs.



Unplug

Turn off and unplug any electronics not in use. Leaving your computer, tv, or hair dryer plugged in wastes energy!



thermostat

Keep your thermostat at a reasonable temperature! Turn down the AC and use a fan. Consider getting a smart thermostat (which can be programmed to adjust the temperature according to your schedule).



Home Insulation

Make sure your home is properly insulated and your windows and doors are air-tight. For a quick-fix, try insulated curtains!



Appliances

Using energy efficient household appliances can make a huge difference in energy consumption.



HVAC

Use an energy-efficient water heater, furnace, and air conditioner.



Use cold water

Wash your laundry in cold water instead of hot.

AIR CONDITIONERS

Replace old air conditioners with energy efficient ones or evaporative coolers.



REFRIGERATORS

Replace refrigerators manufactured before 1999 with newer, energy efficient ones.



WEATHERIZATION

Minor home repairs that keep your home warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.



LIGHTING

Replace old lightbulbs with energy efficient, LED lightbulbs.



POOL PUMPS

Pool pumps in single-family homes with in-ground pools could be eligible for an energy efficient replacement.

Replace or repair old water heaters, receive water heater blankets.



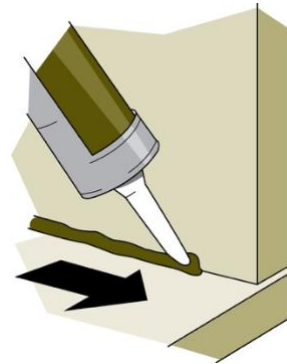
SHOWER HEADS

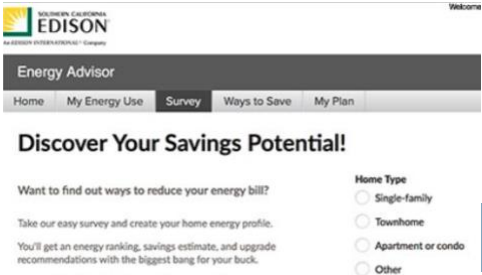

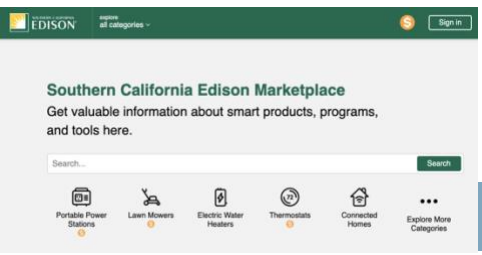

Provides an additional daily allowance of energy, at a baseline rate, for customers with certain medical conditions.

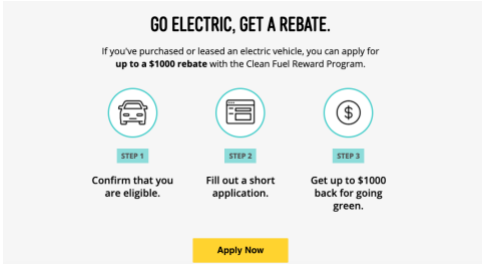
