**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE CARPINTERIA CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, APRIL 10, 2023 AT 5:30 p.m.**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at a regular meeting of the City Council on Monday, April 10, 2023 at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 5775 Carpinteria Avenue, Carpinteria, California to consider adoption of an ordinance prohibiting fuel gas plumbing infrastructure in new construction, as further described:

Ordinance No. 764, Adding Chapter 8.30 to Title 8 of the Carpinteria Municipal Code, a Prohibition of Fuel Gas Plumbing Infrastructure in Newly Constructed Buildings

The Council will consider adoption of Ordinance No. 764, which proposes to prohibit fuel gas infrastructure in “new construction,” generally defined as a building that has never before been used or occupied for any purpose, and projects where the alteration or addition exceeds 50% of the area of an existing building or where the value of the alteration exceeds 50% of the estimated value of the existing building. Approval of Ordinance No. 764 is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) pursuant to sections 15061(b)(3), 15307, and 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines.
