City of Carpinteria Procedure for Providing Information to Interested Persons with Disabilities

The City will, upon request, provide appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for qualified persons with disabilities so they can attend and participate equally in the City's programs, services, and activities, including qualified sign language interpreters, documents in large print and Braille, and other ways of making information and communications accessible to people who have speech, hearing, or vision impairments.

The City of Carpinteria currently^{*} has available the following methods to provide information to interested persons with disabilities:

- City Council and Planning Commission meetings are streamed live on the City's web page (archives are also available on-line)
- DVD recordings of City Council and Planning Commission meetings are available for review or purchase
- City public meeting agendas include a contact number if special assistance is needed
- Audio recording (in MP3 format) of the Architectural Review Board meetings can be made available for review
- Assistive listening systems are available in the City Council Chambers
- Community information is aired via electronic scroll (text) on the City's Government Access Television channel
- Various Carpinteria City Government, as well as other additional information, is available on the City's web site
- The City's Parks & Recreation program registration form provides a means to communicate special needs of children
