SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 776
(AS PRESCRIBED BY GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 36933(C)(1))

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CARPINTERIA REPEALING AND REPLACING IN ITS
ENTIRETY CARPINTERIA MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 8.50,
REGULATING POLYSTYRENE PRODUCTS AND SINGLE-USE
PLASTICS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT this Ordinance was duly introduced for first reading at the Carpinteria City Council meeting of January 8, 2024. A second reading and adoption of the Ordinance is scheduled for January 22, 2024, at 5:30 pm, City Hall, 5775 Carpinteria Avenue, Carpinteria, CA.

Summary of Ordinance: If adopted, this Ordinance would expand the regulations to a prohibition of all polystyrene foodware and packaging material; add language regarding bundling and packaging to comply with AB 1276; remove the term “marine degradable” from the Ordinance language; redefine “compostable” and “recyclable” to align with SB 54 definitions; incorporate amendments to the California Health and Safety Code, allowing reusable foodware; and add language prohibiting the distribution of all mylar balloons, as well as the distribution of latex balloons filled with air or gases lighter than air.
