



Summary of General Plan Community Workshop, 7/8/2025

The Community Development Department hosted a General Plan Community Workshop on July 8, 2025 from 6:00 to 7:30pm at the Carpinteria Community Library. The intent of the workshop was to create a space for community members to engage with the draft Coastal Land Use Plan/General Plan (“CLUP/GP”) and City staff members in a less formal setting— other recent CLUP/GP Update meetings have been held in City Council Chambers. Seven City staff members and approximately 35 members of the public were present at the workshop. Pizza and salad were provided for all attendees.

The workshop began with a staff presentation and slideshow to provide attendees with an overview of the CLUP/GP: what purpose the document serves, the update process to date, what’s new in the updated CLUP/GP, and what comes next. Following the presentation, staff received public comments from the attendees and responded to general questions. Then, the attendees divided into small groups with 1-2 staff members at each to have more detailed conversations about attendees’ topics of interest.

The event was advertised in the City Manager’s report on 6/9/2025 and 6/23/2025, in the Coastal View News print edition on 6/5/2025, through both the City’s general e-newsletter and the CLUP/GP e-newsletter, and on the City’s social media accounts.
